From the published paper by professor D.S. Kshitsova's, Masaryk University, Brno, the Czech Republic: "Undoubtedly, the art education of Czech scholars in the field of Russian studies is primarily based on the study of Russian literature and culture. However, the Brno literary school has always worked traditionally using a comparative approach and thus considers Russian culture based not only on a comparison with the national culture, but also from a multilateral perspective, broader international and interdisciplinary space. As a result, the art education the students receive has the necessary coherence based on a combination of the development of native culture and other cultures of the world, in particular – Russian culture".

The participants of the International Roundtable discussed the perspectives of future connections between official institutions and educational organizations in the environment of CIS Countries and stressed:

- The importance of unified actions between partners of CIS Countries in order to strengthen the significance of the art education in the modern world;
- The necessity of developing different innovative forms to transmit art education accomplishments to the modern world;
- The inevitability of activation of the bilingual informational resource "Observatory on Arts Education in the CIS Countries" to make intercultural dialogue more efficient and resourceful;

The prospects of academic studies promotions based on the national strategies of art education development and international cooperation (from the Resolution of the Roundtable).
