The history of our school

It was established as a successor of the German High School of Trade founded in 1883. Owing to the great trade importance of our town, a trade department was developed at the German School a plan to study bookkeeping, shorthand and other commercial items.

In 1909 the school was recognized by the Ministry of Commerce for regular business school. For a while classes were suspended, but later recovered all divisions and classes, and in 1918 was again recognized by the Ministry of Commerce of regular school.

In 1929 the school was acknowledged by the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Trade as a high trade school. The students came from all over the country because the school's objective was to prepare well-educated people in the whole field of the economic science and practice for the needs of the international trade of the country.

In 1944 the High School of Trade was acknowledged as a successor of the German High School of Trade by the Council of Ministers (Act 2).

Elias Canetti was an Austrian Jewish writer, who received the Nobel Prize for Literature in 1981.

He was born in Ruse on July 25, 1905, where he experienced the first years of his childhood. Canetti received the Nobel Prize for his book "The Tongue", which describes the memories of his early years.



The school today



A school partner in the classroom and extracurricular activities is the **School Board of Trustees**, which has been functioning since 2000. Today, the school offers its students a combination of quality general schooling, economic theory and practice, computer technologies and foreign languages.

Today, 650 students in 25 classes are taught at this school. All 45 teachers are university graduates, 20 of them have supplementary professional qualification levels - from 1 to 5.



Specialities

Vocational fields taught at the school are:

Economic management and administration

Speciality – Economics and Management

Accountancy and Taxes

Speciality – Operational accounting

Speciality – Customs and tax administration

Secretarial and Office Activities

Speciality – Business Administration

Applied Informatics

Speciality – E-commerce

In all these specialities, the students are prepared to analyze and keep account of any kind of business-economic information, to get to know the contemporary process of marketing as a basis for entrepreneur activities and as a means of developing economic (business) thinking. Students study the organization and technology of customs and tax activities, learn English, German and Russian languages. Schooling in the field of information technologies and foreign languages allows a wide range of managerial tasks to be solved under the conditions of market economy and informational society at home and abroad.



Realization

This complex education prepares students for the finale and offers them many possibilities:

- to continue their education in higher schools either in Bulgaria or overseas**
- to be included in the financial and accounting teams of economic practice**
- to start their own business on the basis of the specialities they have studied.**

The overall activities of Secondary School of Economics and Management “Elias Canetti”, Ruse at present and for the future are and will be subject to its mission to give a real chance to young people to win the competition on the labour market by teaching in conformity with European standards.



Students' Council

Students' Council is a body of student self-government organization, established at school in 2002. It includes representatives of all 25 classes. The choices are made at the beginning of each school year, according to specific criteria developed by the students themselves. Students' Council is a permanent Youth Parliament and holds its sessions on a weekly basis.



National competitions
