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Outcomes and Impacts

- Support school passed outs to choose preferred path of study and direct them to nearest TVET centre
- Opportunity for broad selection of careers and thereby relevant courses by looking at various Occupational Outlooks
- Opportunity to apply online for the preferred course easily with a centrally co-ordinated system
- Opportunity to apply for preferred job free of charge
- Support for employers to find skilled employees free of charge
- Enhance the youth transition in Sri Lanka by reducing gap between school to training and training to employment



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Measurement and reports of the outcomes

- The initiative is being considered for further expansion with complementary SMS job search system
- Outputs from different programmes are measured and numbers are collected to National Centre for monitoring and evaluation
- Network progress is presented in every monthly progress review meeting.
- Reduce unemployment and improve employability of TVET graduates providing equal access to vulnerable groups and females
