## Introduction

This is an index of CAME documents edited on cards in 1949, typed in 1977 and reproduced on microfiche in 1990. The index refers to subject words, geographical and personal names; it also refers to the items on agenda under: (plenary) 'Meetings', 'Executive Bureau' and the names of Commissions and Committees. Names of persons appear also under the name of the country they are representing. Note that 'Unesco' is filed after 'United Kingdom'.

The archives came into the possession of Unesco partly through the Unesco Preparatory Commission partly upon the initiative of the Unesco Executive Board: it sent one of its Members, Dr. Jan Opocensky on mission to London in 1948 to take the necessary measures to collect the archives and have them deposited with Unesco (Board documents: 9 EX/12, 11 EX/16, decisions: 8 EX/Dec.21, 11 EX/Dec.8; Registry file: REG X 07 A 1 CAME/246, 1st series).(i).

(i) Dr. Opocensky (1885-1961) was Member of the Board 1946-1948, participant in CAME 1943-1945 and Chief Delegate to ECCO/CONF. and signatory of the Unesco Constitution in 1945, later Vice Chairman of the Preparatory Commission, Delegate at the first General Conference in 1946 and Chief Delegate at the second session 1947, also Permanent Delegate of Czechoslovakia at Unesco. He became Unesco staff member in 1949 and served until 1957; he was the Unesco Archivist 1950-1955; he edited in 1949-1950 a study on the Beginnings of Unesco I-II, a text which is available for consultation in the Unesco Archives and also accessible on microfiche 90S 0105 (11 fiches). Dr. Opocensky was the Archivist of the Czechoslovak Foreign Ministry 1920-1936 and 1945-1946, Consul-general in Paris 1936-1938 and later Librarian and records keeper of the Ministry for Foreign Affairs in the exile Government in London directed by Edvard Beneš.
