### Ceremony to mark the 60th anniversary of UNESCO

To mark the 60th anniversary of UNESCO, the Plenary of the General Conference will hold an exceptional Session at 3:15p.m. in Room I. The ceremony will be honored by the official visit of His Excellency Mr Hamid , the President of the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan and His Excellency , President of the Federal Republic of Germany who will both Mr Horst Kler address the delegates.

During the ceremony, Ludwig van Beethoven's Symphony No. 9 in D minor, op. 125 (listed under the Memory of the World Register) will be performed by the Frankfurt Radio Symphony Orchestra, conducted by Eliahu Inbal, and UNESCO Choir. This will be followed by the projection of the film "Impulse" which recalls the key moments in the history of UNESCO.

Delegates are requested to be seated in Room I at 3:00 p.m. at the latest after which doors will be closed until the end of the ceremony. Live broadcast of the entire ceremony will be available in Room IV.

The ceremony will be followed by the inauguration of the Exhibition "Education for All" by the Director-General in the presence of Her Royal Highness Princess Firyal, UNESCO Goodwill Ambassador for Education for All, and the launching of Literacy Initiative for Empowerment (LIFE) at **700 p.m.** in Hall Ségur.

### **Farewell**

Three weeks ago, we welcomed you to the 33<sup>rd</sup> session of the General Conference, providing you with information tools such as the website of the General Conference, the Mini Journal, the Flash supplements, the screens, and the live *webcast* covering some of the Conference's major events. We hope that these tools provided you with the necessary information and helped facilitate your work throughout the General Conference.

During the last three weeks, more than 400,000 pages of the website have been consulted, representing an average of 3,500 visitors a day, of which 60% are external. These figures surpass the already high number of consulted pages recorded two years ago. Furthermore, as a new service, the *webcast* recorded over 10,000 hits.

The following figures of participation have been recorded for the current session: 3,733 participants; 188 Member States, four Associate Member States and two Non-Member States registered, 3,203 delegates of whom eight Heads of State and Government, two Vice-Presidents, seven Deputy Prime Ministers, and 218 Ministers. In addition, there were 350 journalists and 495 observers (473 of whom were from non-governmental and intergovernmental organizations, 13 from other UN agencies, and nine from other entities).

We are now bidding you farewell and wishing you a safe trip home. We look forward to welcoming you again to the 34<sup>th</sup> session of the General Conference.
