

Three weeks ago, we welcomed you to the 32<sup>nd</sup> session of the General Conference, providing you with information tools such as the *Webzine*, the *Mini-Journal*, the *Flash* supplements and the screens, with the hope that these tools would be helpful, guide you and facilitate your work during the Conference.

The successful introduction of the online information two years ago has been confirmed once again during the current session, making the General Conference website an important information and working tool for the participants. Since the opening of the 32<sup>nd</sup> session, more than 250,000 pages of the *Webzine* have been consulted, representing an average of 2,500 visitors a day, 30% of which are external.

The following figures of participation have been recorded for the current session: 3,577 participants and 430 journalists; 185 States Members registered; 2,999 Delegates of whom: 5 Heads of State, the First Lady of the United States of America, 3 Vice Presidents, 2 Deputy Prime Ministers and 297 Ministers. In addition, there were 551 observers of which 462 non-governmental organizations and 65 intergovernmental organizations.
