An Act revising subparagraph C from the Bill concerning Palaces of Niavaran and Sa'd-abad, evaluation and maintenance of the pertinent properties thereof...

An Act revising subparagraph C from the Bill concerning Palaces of Niavaran and Sa'd-abad, evaluation and maintenance of the pertinent properties thereof, and adding 4 notes thereto; dated: march 10, 1982

Single Article – The Subparagraph C of the above-mentioned Bill shall be revised as the following, and 4 notes will be added thereto:

Subparagraph C – The Ministry of Economy and Finance Affairs is hereby authorized to sell off all the objects subject of the above Bill, priced as less than 10'000'000 Rials and not advised to be maintained in museums, following the confirmation of a commission composed of the representatives of Prime Ministerial, National Attorney General, and the Ministry of Economy and Finance Affairs, and observing the pertinent regulations.

Note 1 – Selling any parts installed to the monument, separation of which would damage the monument or impair the parts thereof, is prohibited.

Note 2 – The funds derived from selling the properties and objects subject of this single article shall be transferred to Public Revenue Account by the Central Bank of Iran.

Note 3 – All cars pertaining to the palaces shall be devoted to the state.

Note 4 – All jewels and gold wares pertaining to all the palaces shall be transferred to the Central Bank of Iran.

The above Act including a Single Article and 4 Notes was approved by the Islamic Consultative Assembly and confirmed by Council of the Guardians on Sunday Feb 28, 1982.
