Law on Exemption of Monuments and Places, Registered Among the National Heritage of Iran, from Municipal Charges

Date: Feb 27, 1992

No: S-997

Single article – All the historical monuments, places and sites which are in possession or ownership of Iranian Cultural Heritage Organization, as well as monuments and places in natural or legal persons' possession or ownership, registered or to be registered in the List for National Heritage of Iran according to the pertinent Laws, and also the museums affiliated to the above-mentioned Organization – shall be exempted from all the municipal charges.

The foregoing Law, including a Single Article has been passed by the Islamic Consultative Assembly during its open session on Wednesday Feb 12, 1992 and confirmed by Council of the Guardians on Feb 21, 1992.
