The ALADIN network supports the international sharing of adult learning resources, information and expertise through various projects that are co-ordinated by the Head of Documentation at the UNESCO Institute for Lifelong Learning.

It emerged from a CONFINTEA V workshop in 1997 and currently links approximately 100 adult learning documentation and information services in about 50 countries.



Today the ALADIN website serves as the most comprehensive documentation platform on adult learning by providing access to:

- detailed information about all ALADIN members and their information services
- 200 annotated and organised adult learning links
- constantly updated ALADIN news
- various ALADIN training tools
