Subject: Call for nominations for the Carlos J. Finlay UNESCO Prize for Microbiology

Sir/Madam,

I am pleased to invite your Government to submit nominations for the Carlos J. Finlay UNESCO Prize for Microbiology.

Funded by the Government of Cuba, the Prize aims to reward the efforts of an individual or institution, or of a non-governmental organization or other entity which, through research and development, has made an outstanding contribution to the field of microbiology (including immunology, molecular biology, genetics, etc.) and its applications.

The candidates should be designated by the governments of Member States, in consultation with their National Commissions for UNESCO, science institutions and associations, and non-governmental organizations in official partnerships with UNESCO and active in relevant fields covered by the Prize. Nominations or applications from individuals will not be accepted.
