status of education



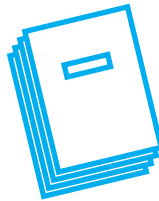
The Database takes stock of the implementation of the right to education in 195 Member States through constitutional and legislative frameworks and educational policies. It also provides information on the monitoring of the implementation of international standard-setting instruments.

195 country profiles on the status of the right to education



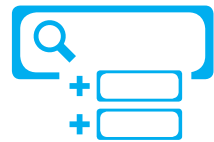
Over 1,000 documents including constitutions, legislations and policies on the right to education around the world

In addition, the Database is a unique source of over 1,000 national documents, compiling Member States' constitutions, laws and decrees, as well as programmes and plans, relevant to the right to education. Those official texts may be available in various languages.

Why is the Database important?

- ▶ Helps monitor the right to education in Member States
- ▶ Facilitates research and policy evaluation
- ▶ Helps governments ensure accountability and transparency
- ▶ Informs citizens and governments of their rights and duties concerning education
- ▶ Fosters regional and international cooperation

The Database is for United Nations specialized agencies, programmes and human rights bodies, government officials, ministries of education, civil society and non-governmental organizations, legal experts, educationalists, students and researchers, journalists, and the international community at large.
