<b>Summary of debate</b>	<p>- Item 6.4 – The representative of the Director-General (Assistant Director-General for Social and Human Sciences) introduced the item. The debate on item 6.4 took place, during which thirty-two (32) Member States and one (1) observer took the floor. The representative of the Director-General (Assistant Director-General for Social and Human Sciences) replied to the comments and issues raised by Member States. The Commission examined the Draft Resolution on item 6.4 as amended by 38 C/COM.SHS/DR.1, which it recommended to the General Conference to adopt with amendment.</p> <p>- Item 8.4 – The representative of the Director-General (Assistant Director-General for Social and Human Sciences) introduced the item. The debate on item 8.4 took place, with nine (9) Member States taking the floor. The Commission examined the Draft Resolution on item 8.4 and recommended to the General Conference that it adopt it without amendment.</p>
