

This request for accreditation is a consequence to the bullfighting lobby explicit interest in presenting in a near future a candidature to declare this activity Intangible Cultural Heritage.

This NGO, which gathers the main animal-protection associations in Spain, and works closely with others in Spain, Portugal, México, Venezuela, Costa Rica, Peru, Colombia, US, France, Holland, Germany and the UK, represents the wider amount of people worldwide who believe that bullfighting is animal abuse and therefore should never be declared ICH.

The bullfighting candidature would be a unique case, for UNESCO would face defenders but also a very strong opposition. For this reason, we believe fair for this honourable institution to get advisory services from both sides.

Our objectives are:

1. Create a harmonious relationship between human beings and animals.

- 2. Promote among our communities values against violence towards animals.
- 4. Perform public campaigns to educate society against public violent sports and shows towards animals, like bullfighting.
- 5. Work closely with private and public entities towards this aim.

These objectives are in conformity with the spirit of UNESCO and the ICH Convention according to the following extracts:

UNIVERSAL DECLARATION ON BIOETHICS AND HUMAN RIGHTSAS, 19 October 2005. UNESCO

- a)UNESCO declares being "Aware that human beings are an integral part of the biosphere, with an important role in protecting one another and other forms of life, IN PARTICULAR ANIMALS".
- b)Article 17– "Protection of the environment, the biosphere and biodiversity Due regard is to be given to the interconnection between human beings and other forms of life [...] importance given to respect for traditional knowledge and to the role of human beings in the protection of the environment, the biosphere and biodiversity."
- c) Article 12 The importance of cultural diversity and pluralism should be given due regard. However, such considerations are not to be invoked to infringe upon human dignity, human rights and fundamental freedoms, NOR UPON THE PRINCIPLES SET OUT IN THIS DECLARATION, nor to limit their scope.

ICH CONVENTION:

Nevertheless, the uniqueness of this request does not make it less valuable, for it aims at safeguarding the purity of the ICH list, and "the invaluable role of the intangible cultural heritage as a factor in bringing human beings closer together and ensuring exchange and understanding among them", as it is stated in the last paragraph of the introduction to the Convention text itself.

For this reason, we hope this request will be accepted and not disregarded because of its uniqueness.

The member associations forming part of this organization as well as other collaborating ones, have carried out comprehensive investigation and reports, some of which are listed below (member association which carried them out in brackets).

- b) Counter-arguments agains the benefits of bullfighting on the environment (FAADA)
- c) Violence towards animals and its effects on human to human violence (GEVHA)
- d) The phychologycal dangers of bullfighting for young spectators (CAS INTERNATIONAL)
- e) Opinion polls on bullfighting among Spaniards (ADDA)
- f) Gathering of polls on bullfighting in all countries where bullfighting takes place (APEA)

- g) History of bullfighting (APEA)
- e) Gathering the opinion of 275 scientific emminences around the world on bullfighting (PROU)
- f) Gathering of municipalities around the world which have declared themselves against bullfighting (CAS INTERNATIONAL)
- g) Gathering of national and international culture, political and social personalities who declare themselves against bullfighting (over 700, from Nobel Prize John M. Coetze, to the Dalai Lama, many actors, writers, academic personalities, etc.)
- 2. EDUCATION AND AWARENESS:
- a) On March 28, 2010 this organization organized the biggest demonstration against bullfighting ever, with over 15.000 people in Madrid and the presence of many personalities from the cultural world.
- b) Since then, this organisation, its member associations and collaborators around the world have been carrying out many actions to inform about bullfighting in all regions and countries where this activity takes place.
- c) This organization has published different literature to inform the general public on the suffering of the bull and the benefits of educating our children in the respect to all creatures and violence-zero towards all species.
- d) This organization has released numerous press releases to national and international media regarding bullfighting and the respect towards animals.
- e) Programs in schools about the respect for animals and the environment, free courses for the general public on the same subject (ALBA, ANAA).
- 3. ACTIONS WITH OR TOWARDS OTHER PUBLIC OR PRIVATE ENTITIES.
- a) This association has prepared the document "Society and Bullfighting", and sent it to the main bullfighting sponsors, some of which have decided to stop their sponsoring after analysing it. (CAS International, APEA)
- b) Along with its international mate-associations, we have sent common requests to top politicians in Bogotá, México DF, and Panama, to abolish bullfighting. (APEA, CAS International)
- c) We have performed numerous meetings with local, regional and national politicians to work on common programs to erradicate violence against animals (APEA, FAPAM, FFW, LIBERA!, ADDA, ANIMA NATURALIS, DEFENZOORES, AMEDEA MANT, CRAC, FLAC, among others.)
- d) We have met with different sectors of the educational world (parents of alumni, teachers associations and unions.

4. LEGAL ACTIONS

a) This organization has presented several legal recourses and claims against the declaration of bullfighting as cultural asset as well as against cases of animal abuse (APEA, JUSTICIA ANIMAL, SPAP Madrid, PACMA)

This organization is by itself the best demonstration of mutual respect and communities, groups and individuals that collaborate for the construction of a more ethical society where violence is not accepted.

- 1. COOPERATION AMONG ASSOCIATIONS WITH DIFFERENT OBJECTIVES. The associations that form this organization, have very different views on how far should animal rights go. Some only work in the field of pets. Others believe that it is enough with obtaining a minimum level of welfare among our farm animals. While others believe animals should be free of any human exploitation. Regardless of our very different views we have managed to find our common points and work on them with much success and in total respect of the different opinions that the associates of each of our member associations have.
- 2. COOPERATION AMONG DIFFERENT REGIONS, DIFFERENT COUNTRIES, DIFFERENT CULTURES. This organization gather associations from very different parts of Spain, like Catalonia, Galicia, Madrid, Andalucia, etc.. and collaborates with many others all around the Spanish territory. Despite the different weight of bullfighting in each of them and the cultural and language differences among us, our collaboration has always been very fruitful. Likewise, we are part of the antibullfighting network which gathers associations from Spain, Portugal, France, UK, US, México, Venezuela, Costa Rica, Ecuador, Perú, Colombia. Regardless of all our cultural and language difference, our collaboration is more and more productive everyday. This international collaboration is specially rewarding for it brings together people with very different background, cultural experience, education or religious beliefs.
- 3. COOPERATION WITH DIFFERENT SECTORS OF OUR SOCIETY. This organization believes a more ethical and prosperous society is built through private and public collaboration.

Thus, we have worked closely with the world of culture, sport and education.

We have also collaborated with the political world, mainly through our animal party PACMA but also by helping political parties include animal protection issues in their electoral programs.

Likewise, we have collaborated with the legal and scientific world, with regards of violence to animals, the suffering of the bull or the psychological effects of bullfighting or violence towards animals on humans.



Estimados Diputados y Senadores miembros de las Cortes Generales,

Nos dirigimos a ustedes con el fin de ponerles en conocimiento de un movimiento popular masivo que se viene produciendo de manera espontánea por todo el territorio nacional.

La gran mayoría de los ciudadanos de este país estamos hartos, a la vez que nos sentimos impotentes, de tener noticias cada día de brutales casos de maltrato animal, como el del cachorro conocido como Schnauzi. Con tan solo dos meses de vida, torturado por un individuo durante mas de 11 horas, de formas tan crueles que ni siguiera éramos capaces de imaginar hasta entonces, grabándolo en video y publicándolo en internet.

Miles de personas, horrorizadas ante las terribles imágenes, nos unimos a través de las redes sociales para encontrar a este sujeto.

Fue entonces cuando nos preguntamos, que sucedería si conseguiamos dar con el.

En España no tenemos una Ley de Protección Animal.

Cada Comunidad Autónoma tíene una legislación diferente, lo que significa que los animales, dependiendo de donde se encuentren, reciben una mayor, menor o nula protección.

De acuerdo con las penas previstas en el Código Penal, en caso de ser detenido, procesado y finalmente condenado, este individuo se enfrentaría a una pena máxima de entre 3 y 12 meses de cárcel, por lo que en caso de no tener antecedentes penales, solo tendría que pagar una multa.

Desgraciadamente el caso de Schnauzi es 'solo' uno más.

El dolor infligido a todos estos animales indefensos no puede repararse, pero el fin de una pena también consiste en prevenir la comisión de un delito ¿Cómo pretender disuadir a los potenciales maltratadores cuando saben que solo van a tener que enfrentarse a una ridícula sanción económica?

No nos sentimos seguros frente a este tipo de sujetos, y consideramos que no solo son peligrosos para los animales, sino también para las personas, como así lo demuestran los estudios científicos (el maltrato animal es un signo de alarma psiquiátrica).

Por todo ello, el pasado 25 de marzo convocamos 59 manifestaciones simultáneas, a las que se unieron más de 100.000 personas y hemos llevado a cabo la recogida de cerca de 400.000 firmas de las que les hacemos entrega, con la intención de ejercer el derecho de patición que nos reconoce la Constitución.

Solicitamos de las Cortes un endurecimiento real y efectivo de las penas por maltrato animal. Consideramos también que ya es hora de que nuestro pais se adhiera a la Convención Europea sobre Protección de Animales de Compañía, elaborada hace 25 años por el Consejo de Europa, y que España, pese a ser miembro de dicho Consejo, aun no ha ratificado.

Esta vez esperamos que nos escuchen como las personas que elegimos como nuestros legitimos representantes en el Poder Legislativo, que recuerden el significado de lo que supone la representación en democracia, y reformen las normas en consideración a lo que la mayoría entendemos algo esencial; el respeto por la vida de seres que sufren y padecen a diario el maltrato, como son los animales de este país.
