UNESCO is launching a global report on **governance issues in education**

The report, to be launched in June 2016, draws on a series of regional reviews commissioned to internationally recognized experts in the field.

With a focus on the Education 2030 Framework for Action the report uses an international comparative perspective to address, among others, the following questions:

1. How well adapted to the emerging needs of the education sector are the existing governance models?
2. What are the most salient governance issues that have emerged during the past decade? In particular,
 - Multiplication of stakeholders
 - Influence of international or regional players
 - Marketisation and/or privatisation
 - Lack of government capacity
3. What have been the major governance reforms in education over the past decade?
4. What lessons can be learnt?
