The term Open Educational Resources (OER) was adopted at UNESCO's Forum on Open Courseware in 2002

OER are any educational resources that may be

- <u>freely</u> accessed, copied, re-used, adapted and shared
- available under an <u>open license</u> or are in the public domain for use without paying royalties / license fees.

Free vs Open

Free does not mean free to reuse, share or change

Openly licensed resources have clear permissions

- Retain: Users have the right to make, archive, and "own" copies of the content
- Reuse: Content can be reused in its unaltered form
- Revise: Content can be adapted, adjusted, modified or altered Remix: The original or revised content can be combined with
 - other content to create something new
- Redistribute: Copies of the content can be shared with others in its original, revised or remixed form
