TCG Members


- Maximum 36 ex officio members who are experts in the field of education statistics

- DIR/UIS and DIR ED/ESC will co-Chair

WG1: Indicator development

- This Working Group (or Groups) will take forward the further development of selected indicators
 - Diagnose implementation difficulties
 - Work plan for methodological development
 - Recommendations to improve data coverage
- Report to the next meeting of the TCG

WG2: Capacity-building

- This Working Group will advise on statistical capacity-development needs and mechanisms to support countries
 - Identify data production capacity bottlenecks globally and nationally
 - Develop an SDG 4 Education 2030 capacity development assessment framework
 - Produce a statistical capacity needs report
 - Consider the establishment of a mechanism to coordinate development partners to support the development of national statistical development strategies for education

WG3: Countries' reporting

- This Working Group will establish the basic principles and guidelines to be adopted by the TCG for SDG 4 reporting
 - Comprehensive guide on global data reporting
 - Support development of a manual on implementation of data and metadata reporting and dissemination
