- to implement programs and activities of UNESCO’s sectoral mandates such as development of relevant curriculum materials and resources

Solomon Islands will continue to advocate together with other Pacific Islands countries to ensure that Pacific Islands call for consideration of issues surrounding climate change is addressed by UNESCO and other UN agencies.

Climate Change is indeed the most critical threat to our very existence in the Pacific and there is a need for the industrialised nations to honor their obligations to reduce global temperature increase.

I cannot but express our concern about the current process put in place to insert our voice in UNESCO. We need a reserved seat in the Executive board as this is where the voice of Pacific Islands States can be heard and needs can be discussed.
