

The Emergency Safeguarding of the Syrian Cultural Heritage project was officially launched on 1 March 2014. Funded by the European Union with the support of the Flemish Government and the Government of Austria, it aims to provide an operational response to halt the on-going loss of cultural heritage and to prepare post-conflict priority actions in Syria.

Through a Project Management Unit based at the UNESCO Office in Beirut, UNESCO is implementing a three pronged approach to monitor and assess the cultural heritage situation in Syria through updated and continued knowledge and documentation; mitigate the destruction and loss of Syrian cultural heritage through national and international communication and awarenes-raising efforts; and protect and safeguard Syrian cultural heritage through enhanced technical assistance and capacity building activities for national stakeholders and beneficiaries.


