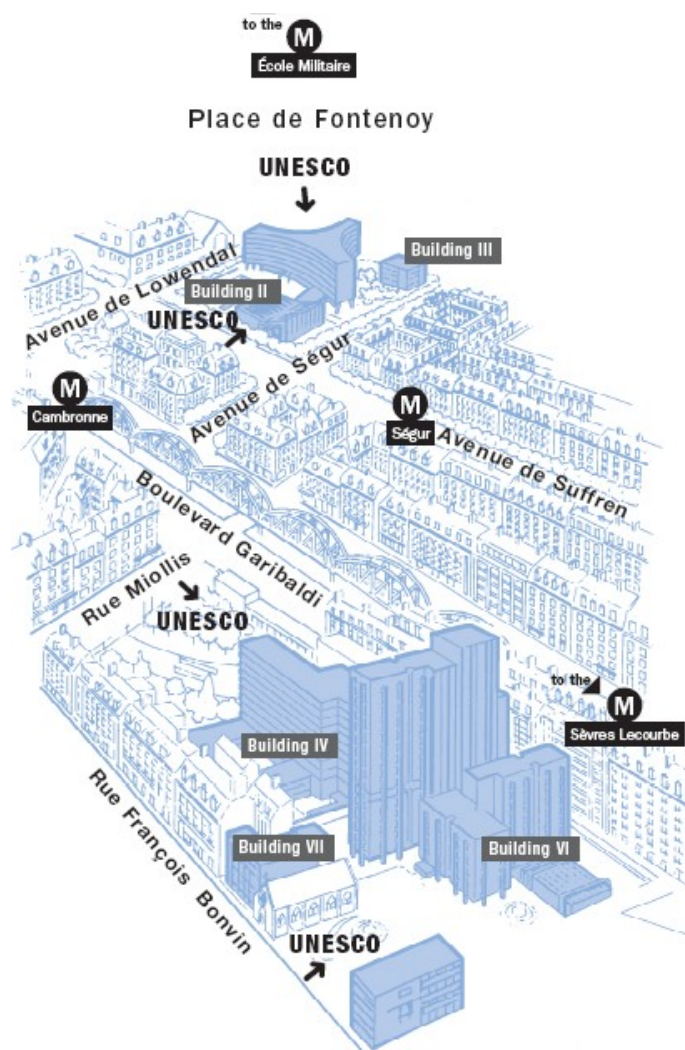

## **Access to UNESCO's Premises**

To enter the premises, you must have your passport or other form of government issued identification. In accordance with security procedures, badges are provided to visitors to enable them to access UNESCO. The badges are presented at the entrance check points and are to be worn at all times within the UNESCO compound.

## **Electricity**

Please note that the Type E electrical socket is used in France. You will need to bring an adapter to connect your notebook or phone charger.

## **Banking Services**

**Bank Société Générale:** Ground floor of the Fontenoy Building.

Opening hours: Monday to Friday from 9.30 a.m. to 12.15 p.m. and 1.15 p.m. to 5.15 p.m.

## **UNESCO Commissary**

The UNESCO Commissary, which offers tax-free articles (fine food, perfumes, gifts, etc.), is situated on the ground floor and basement level of the Fontenoy Building.

## **Transportation Services**

### **From the airport Roissy-Charles de Gaulle to Paris, UNESCO area**

By train: RER B to Denfert Rochereau

Correspondence by subway (*Métro*), Line 6 towards **Charles de Gaulle**

**Étoile**, get off at the **Sèvres Lecourbe** station. One underground ticket is valid for one trip regardless of the distance travelled. It is cheaper to buy 10 tickets at a time - ask for a "carnet".

By airport shuttle: Air France buses are available at the airport. The nearest stop to UNESCO is the **Montparnasse station**. Once at the station, take the metro Line 6 to **Sevres Lecourbe** or **Cambronne** stations.

By taxi: Follow the taxi signs at the airport. You may have to stand in a queue but this should move fast. Expect to pay 60 to 80 Euros.

By regular bus: Once in Paris, you may use the same tickets, coupons and cards as for the metro, one ticket per trip. You must validate the tickets on the bus. The following buses pass near UNESCO Bus numbers: 28, 80, 82, 87 and 92.

### **Medical Emergencies**

For medical emergencies, call the SAMU (tel.: 15). If you need a doctor, call SOS Médecins (tel.: 01 43 37 77 77). You can also call the emergency service of St. Joseph's Hospital (185, rue Raymond Losserand 75014, tel.: 01 44 12 34 58).

The Medical Service and infirmary of UNESCO are located on the second floor of the Fontenoy Building. Opening hours: Monday to Friday from 9 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.

There are mail boxes at the Fontenoy Building, close to the main entrance. In an emergency, you will find a post office open all night at 52 rue du Louvre, in the first arrondissement (Paris 75001).

The UNESCO Bookshop is located at the entrance of the Fontenoy Building and sells UNESCO publications, CDs, CD-ROMs, DVDs and some United Nations publications.
