- 1. The Bureau of the Intergovernmental Council of the International Programme for the Development of Communication (IPDC) held its forty-seventh meeting at UNESCO Headquarters in Paris from 29 to 30 March 2004, chaired by Mr Torben Krogh (Denmark) and in the presence of Mr Abdul Waheed Khan, the representative of the Director-General of UNESCO. All the Members of the Bureau were present at the meeting: Luxembourg, Malaysia, Malawi, the Russian Federation, Uruguay, Yemen, as well as the rapporteur, Mr Nacer Mehal (Algeria).
- 2. In accordance with its new functions adopted by the 32nd General Conference, the Bureau proceeded with the examination of 40 projects preliminarily approved by the 23rd Council session in March 2003 as well as of 46 new projects submitted to the IPDC. Following Bureau's deliberations
 - 56 projects, in total, were approved for financing from the IPDC Special Account;
 - 6 projects were approved and received funds-in-trust;
 - 4 projects were approved for eventual funds-in-trust financing.
- 3. Taking into consideration availability of funds in the Special Account as at the end of 2003 (US 1 254,000) and the funds received under funds-in trust arrangements, the Bureau agreed on the following IPDC Budget for 2003:

6. IPDC UNESCO Prize for Rural Communication
