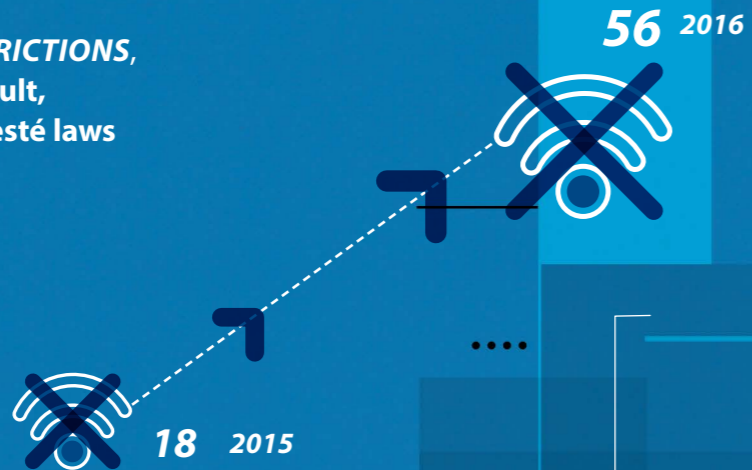

INCREASE IN BLOCKING, filtering and shutdowns



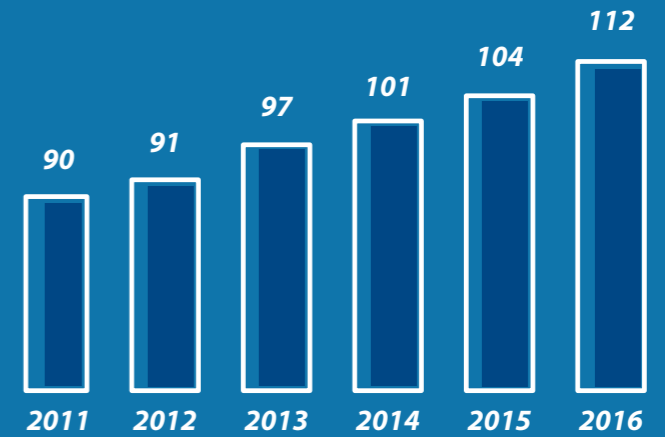
DIGITAL MEDIA have raised new challenges for **privacy** and **journalist source protection**
