We are deeply concerned about the situation in Iraq which poses a risk to all dimensions of human life. The risk to cultural property is no less To this end, we appreciate the efforts of UNESCO in the direction of safeguarding and protecting Iraqi cultural heritage, notably the Emergency Response Action Plan launched in July 2014 which envisages action in the areas of communication and awareness raising, engaging international actors in cultural heritage protection, monitoring the state of protection, technical assistance and advice and damage assessment.

We also welcome the support provided by the Government of France in this regard. The symposium on "Iraqi Heritage at Risk: How to Protect It?" organized jointly by France and Iraq last month was indeed most informative and useful. India congratulates the Governments of France and Iraq for that.
