To raise the awareness on the importance of protecting Victoria Falls, a natural WH site, volunteers explained to local people their motivation to volunteer and their activities at the site. In addition to personal conversation with local residents, volunteers distributed 500 leaflets to tourists and local people.

Volunteers barricaded photographic trail with environmentally friendly materials and installed signs in the paths of the heritage sites and asked visitors not to invade behind the barricad. The heritage commission in Zambia celebrated 97% success rate of the tasks given to the local and international volunteers.
