## Protection of Movable Cultural Heritage Regulations<sup>2</sup> (Amendment)

### 1. Amendment

1.1 The Protection of Movable Cultural Heritage Regulations are amended as set out in these Regulations.

### 2. Schedule

2.1 Part V, paragraph 2 (i):

Omit the paragraph, substitute:

“(i) any holotype of Australian origin:

(i) that is not lodged in an overseas collecting institution; or

(ii) in relation to which a permit or an authority issued under the *Wildlife Protection (Regulation of Exports and Imports) Act 1982* is not in force.”.
