OBJECTS：2．The objects of the Association shall be：－
（1）To initiate and to organise research into the prehistory of New Zealend and related axeas in the Pacific．
（2）To unite all persons engaged or interestec in archaeology by holding conferences and meetings for the discussion of archaeologicel guestions．
（3）To increase anc diffuse inowleage of all matters relating or of interost to archecoloyists and to assist in the spread of this lnowlocee anong the public generaliy．
（4）To strengthen the iinks between the professional and the anatour archaeologist．
（5）To encourage and foster teaching and research in archaeology．
（6）To aifiliate with，establish relations with，become a member of or co－operate with any Association， Society，Body or combination of Associations，Societies or Bodies in New Zealand or elsewhere having objects in any way similar in whole or in part to the objects of this Association。

CLASGES OF
MPMBERSHIP：3．The members of the Association shall consist of：
（a）Ordinary Nembers．
（b）Honorary Members．
（c）Such other classes oi members as the Association in General Meeting or the Council may from time to time resolve。

ORDINARY MIMEERS：

HONORI．RY MEMBERS：

Ordinary Members shall consist of such persons as are electec Ordinary Gembers of the lssociation in accordance with the provisions of Fule $\bar{\sigma}$（a）horeof．

Honorary Vembers shall consist of such Dersois as are elected Honorary wamers in accordance with the provisions of Rule 6 （b）hereof．

SUBSORIPTIONS：4．Until the Association in General leetine otherwise resolves the subscription payeble by mombers shall be as follows：－

Ordinary Members shall gay a subscription of $10 /-$ per annum and in addition an entrance fee of $10 /-$ on first joining the issociation．

COMSEOURIGES 5．（a）If any member shall be twelve months in arrears with OF NOT－PAYNT $T$ his subscription a written request tor the pament due OF SIJBSCRIPTIUA： may be sent to such member and if within one month payment nit the amount has not been made he may be removed from
(b) No member who is twelve months in aprears with his subscription shall be entitled to vote at an Annual Meeting, or stand as a candidate for any office of the Association.

## $\frac{\text { ELSCTION }}{\text { OF MEMB }}$ 6. (a) Opdinary Members: iny person interestec in the objects Of the issociation shall be eligible for election by the Council as an Ordinary Member subject to the following provisions:- <br> (i) A. candidate for clection shall be proposed by an Ordinary or Honorary Member, and the candidate, the proposer and the seconder shall sign and forward to the Secretary a momination form stating the name and address of the candidate.

(ii) The aforesaid nomination form shall be in the hands of the Secretary at least 7 days bufore the date of the Council Meeting at which the election is to take place.
(iii) The method of election shall be by ballot at a meeting of the Council and the Secretary shall provide a voting paper for each member of the Council.
(iv) Each nember of the Council shall strike out from his voting paper the name of any candidate against whom he desires to vote and shall leave uncancelled the name of any candidate for whom he desires to vote and shall write the words "no vote" against the name of any candidate in respect of whom he does not wish to record a vote. The voting papers shall be collected by the Secretary and shall be scrutinized and the votes counted by two members oI the Council nominated by the Chairman for that purpose.
(v) If one third or more of the total votes cast for and ageinst a candidate are against him he shall be deemed not electec.
(b) Honorary Members: Any person who has done outstanding Work in connection with archaeology or has rendered special service to the Association, shall be eligible for election as an Honorery liemoer by the hissociation in General Meeting. The provisions of Rule 6 (a) hereof relating to the election of Ordinery liembers shall apply mutatis mutandis to the election of Honorary Members PROVIDED ELWIVS that the nomination of an Honorary wember may only be made by the Council and the nomination form shall be signed pursumt to a resolution of the Council and by the Secretery and one member thereof. IFO seconder shall be required. An Honorary Nember shall be entitlod to all the rights and privileges of an Ordinary Hember.

FINANCIAL 7. The financial year of the Lssociation shall end on the 28th day of Pebruary in each year.

MANGEGTT 9．The Management and control of the affairs of the Association OF THE ATLIRS OF THE $\angle$ SSOCI－ ATION： shall be vested in the Council which shall have all the powers of the is ociation which are not expressly required by these rules or by the Incorporated Societies l－ct，1908， or its fmendments to be done or exercised by the Association in General liceting or so otherwise provided by these rule PROVIDID IIM．YS：
（a）That the Council shall not borrow more than 250 in any one year on behelf of the issociation without a resolution of an imnual General or Special General Meeting authorizing the Council to borrow a sun or sume in excess on 2250 ．
（b）That the Council may deleciate any of its powers and duties to sub－comittecs consisting of such member or members of the Council as it may resolve and the President and the Secretary shall be or officio members of all such sub－comittces．

CONSTITUTION 10．The Council shall consist of： O．F COUNCII：
（a）Ell officers of the Association．
（b）Six members elected as heroinafter provided．Such nembers must be Ordinary or Honorary Members of the Lssociation。

MOMINATION 11．（1）Nominations for office in respect of officers and \＆ELECTION OF OFFICERS OF COUNCIL： members of the Council shall be called for by the Secretary by circular posted to all members at least 35 days before the Amnual General Mceting．No person having baen Prgsident of the dssociation for two successive years shall be eligible for immediate re－ election as President。
（2）Nominations in writing for any of the above offices must be in the hancs of the Sccretary at least 28 days before the fimual Guneral Meeting．
（3）Fach nomination must be signod by the proposer and seconder both of whom must be Ordinary or Fonorary Members of tho Lssociation，and the nominee must alsc sign the nomination form。

V:CiPION 18. The Offices of President, Vice-Presicent, Member of the OF OFFICE: Council, Honorary Treasurer of Honorary Secretary shall be vacated if any holder:-
(a) Ceascs to bo an Ordinary Momber or an Honorary Member;
or
(b) Resigns his office in writing.

CiSUiL 19. In the event of a vacancy occurring in the Council, or the offices of Presicent, Vico-President, Honorary Socretary or Honorary Treasurer, whother occurring from death, resignation, or otherwisc, the Council may fill such vacancy for the uncxpired tom of office.
(1) The imnual General Meeting of the fissociation shall be held each year as early as is possible after the close of the financial year the $2 \overline{8}$ thoflay of February, and must be held before the lest day/May in each year. The gract date shall be docided by the Council. General Meoting shell be given to each meraber; and such notice shall contain brief detalls of all bueiness to be dealt with at the meeting.

for a time during the moming stand adjourned to $2 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{m}$. on the same day at the same place and in any other casc to the same time and place on tho next following day and if at such adjourned meeting a quorum is not present within half an hour from the tinc appointed themeriburs. then present shall constitute a quorum.

SPECIf, 21.(1) A Special Genoral Moeting may be calloci at any time by GENER:I
MEETINGS: the President, or by resolution of the Council and such a meeting shall be called on the written requisition of six or more Ordinary or Honorary Mombers, provided that the said requisition shall state the motion or motions to be moved thereat.
(2) (a) A Special General Meeting shall be held not earlicr than fiftcen days not later than forty-two days from the date of receipt of a requisition as aforesaid.
(b) If the meeting be not called within the specified time, the members signing the requisition shall have power to convenc a mecting.

NOTICE OF (3) The provisions of Rule 20 rolating to notice of mecting, quorum and lack of quorum shall apply mutatis mutandis to Special General Moctings.

Tho President, if he is prosent at any Goneral or Special OF GENBR:I MEETINGS: Fueting, or any Special Gencral Focting unlese notice thereof has been given in the notice calling the meeting: PROVIDID L. WWIYS that a motion which doos not affect the policy or subscription of the fssociation may, with the sanction of a resolution at any Annual Gencral Meoting, be proposed, discussed and pat to the vote. The decision as to whether or not a motion affects policy shall rest solcliv with the Chairmen. Goneral Meeting shall take the chair at such meeting and if the President is not present thon one of the VicePresicents shall take the chair and if neither of the Vice-eresidents aro present the members prosent and entitled to vote shall oluct a Chairman.

(e) $\Lambda_{\mathrm{a}}$ declaration by the Chairman that on a secret ballot a particular resolution has boen carried or lost and an entry in the issociation's Minutc Book to that effect shall be conclusive evidence of the. fact without proof of the number or proportion of the votes recorded for oragainst the resolution.
(f) A. declaration by the Chaiman that a resolution has on a show of hands been carried or carried unanimously or by a particular majority or lost and an entry to that effect in the l.ssociation's Minute Book shall be conclusive cvidence of the fact without proof of the number or proportion of the votes recorded for or against the resolution.

APPOINTMENT 25. The accounts of the sssociation shall bo audited at the OF SUDITOR: end of each financial year by m Honorary Luditor, who shall be a nember of the Now Zoaland Society of iscountants. The Honorary fuditor shall be appointed each year at the innual General Meeting.

PROPERTY 26. The property and funds of the issociation shall be AND FTUNDS; applied solely towards the promotion of the objocts of the Association and in such manncr as the Council shall from time to time resolve. hil moneys received. by or on hehalf of the Association shall be paid into a bank account with such bank as the Council shail appoint. $\Lambda 11$ accounts shall be subinitted for approval by the Council and shall be paid by cheque drawn on the issociation's account. AIl cheques shall bo signed by one member of the Council and by the Treasurce or such other person as the Council may appoint.


The Registered Office of the Association shall be in the city of Wellington or at such other plece as the Council may from time to time determine.

COMMON SEEL: 28.
The /ssociation shell have a Common Seal which shall be kept in the custody of the Secretary and which shell not be effired to any documont or instrument except pursuant to a resolution of the Council and in the presence of the Secretary and two members of the Council who shall sign any deed or instrument to which the Scal is affixed.
S.LTRR:TION TO RULES:
29. These Rules may be alterod, added to or rescinded at any Annual. General Moeting or Special Goneral Mooting subject to the following concitions:-
(a) Notice of amy proposed alteration in or addition to or rescission of the Rules shall be postod to each member ontitled to receive notices under these Rules at least ten days prior to the date of the meeting at which such altoretion or addition is to be considercd.
(b) No resolution of any such moeting shall cffect any altcration in or addition to or rescission of the Rules unluss it is carried by a majority of at least two-thirds of the total votes cast for and against such resolution.

RESIGN.'TION OF MEMBERS:

POWERS OF COUNCIL IN EVENT OF BREICH OF RULES BY OR MISCONDUCT OF MEMBER:
30. iny member wishing to resign from the issociation must give notice in writing to that cficct to the Socretary prior to the 28 th day of February in the year in which such member wishes to rosign otherwise he shall be liable for the subscription for such year.
31. If the conduct of any member appoars to the Council to be contrary to the interests of the issociation or to endanger the reputation, good order or welrare of the fssociation, or if any member commits a breach of those Rules, the Council may request such member either to appear before it personally at a date to be fixed by the Council or to submit to the Council in writing any explamation or other facts relating to the conduct complained of or the breach of the Rules, and if such member appears beforc the Council he shall be entitled to make any such explanation orally and to address the Council thereon. After the Council has heard the member or considered his written statement, or if the member fails to appear bofore the Council or summit a writton statemont in response to a request to do so then the Council may:-
(1) Deprive such member of all tho rights and privileges of his membership for such period as the Council sees fit。
(2) Expel such mombor from the issociation, and as from the date of the Council's resolution for expulsion, the member shall ceasc thenceforth to be a member of the issociation and shall not thereafter havo any claim on its assets or property, but such casser or membership shall be without prejudice to the Association's right to recover any subscription or other moneys then due. and owing by such member.
(3) Discipline such momber in such othor way as may be \%ithin its powers undor these Rules and under the Incorporated Societies l.ct, 1908, and its imondments.
PROVIDED :IW:YS that the Council shall forthwith notify the momber of its decision by registerud post and any member expelled under the foregoing rule may within fourteen days from the date he reccives notice of the Council's descision make a requost in writing to the Council to call a Special Goneral Moeting of the Lssociation to consider his case. Such moeting shall be held within one calendar month from the rocoipt of such ruquest. Such mecting may by resolution:-
(a) Confirm the Council's resolution for expulsion, or
(b) Reinstate the momber as a momber, or
(c) Impose such penelty other than expulsion on the member as is within the Council's powers under this Rule 31.

The voting at such meating shall be scoret ence the nocessary voting pepers shall be supplied to all mombers attonding the mecting. The momber vho is the subject of the Council's resolution may address tho Special General Mocting and may be representud thereat and borore the
of Now Zealand or by any onc other person chosen by the member concorned. If a quorum is not present at the aforesaid Special Gencral Mceting within half an hour of the time the meeting is called for the resolution of the Council for expulsion shall be demed to be confirmed.

INTERPRET:TION 32. In the case of any doubt, dispute, or difference OF RULES: arising as to the interpretation of thosc Rulcs, tho decision of the Council on such doubt, dispute, or difference shall bo final and binding on all parties: PROVIDED /LPIYS that in the event of any such doubt, dispute, or difference arising at an Annual or Special General Moeting the decision of the Chaimen of such meeting on such doubt, dispute, or difference shall be final and binding on $a l l$ parties.

REGUE/TIONS: 33. The issociation may from time to time by resolution in General Meetine make, amend or rescind regulations not inconsistent with these Rules eoverning procedure at its moetings and publication (if any) of roports thercof and of the busincss of the hssociation in the press.

DISPOSITION: 34. In the ovent of the winding up of the fssociation and there being any surplus of assets remaining aftor payment of all its debts and liabilities such surplus shall be disposed of in such manner as the issociation in Genoral Mecting resolves.

## POWERS:

35. The fssociation shall have power to do all such lewiul acts and things as are incidental or conclucive to the attainment of its objects or any of thom and without prejudice to the gencrality of the foregoing the following powers shall be included in the issociation's powors:-
(a) To purchase, take on les.so or in exchange, hire or otherwise acquire any real or personel property and and rights or priviloges which the Association may think nocessary or convenient.
(b) To raisc monoy by subscriptions, levies or othorwiso and grait any rights and priviloges to subscribers and mombers as may from time to time bu deemed nucossary.
(c) To onter into any contracts, agreements or arrangements with any person, firm, corporation or company which the issociation may deem conducive to the issuciation's objects or any of them.
(d) To invest, lend and deal with the moneys of the fssociction not immediately required for carrying out its objects upon such securitios and in such manner as may from time to time be determined by the Council.
(c) To make, mend, or rescind by-laws or reguletions not inconsistent with those rulos pertaining to the carrying out of all or any of the objects of the Association.
(f) To borrow or Mis money by way of Eank overdraft or on mortgege or by the issue of dobontures or otherwise howsocver and with or without socurity.
