This event was held based on ITC training standards and contents and participants would get the related certificates.







Goals of the Event

The schedule

Opening ceremony

In the opening ceremony of the Event, the messages of Dr. Pakseresht, Deputy Minister of Cooperatives, Labor and Social Welfare and President of Iran Technical & Vocational Training Organization (Iran TVTO), have been addressed by Dr. Azizi, Head of ITC.

In this event, many job consultations had been made. The participants/interviewees would be informed about their interview results.

Complementary programs

In one of the part of this event, a training program on effective communication skills was conducted by Mr. Salimi, entrepreneurship training instructor & chief expert in stock market, and Mr. Karimi, using a training game and simulation. This workshop focused on effective and non-verbal communication skills which conducted through a game and the winner got a prize.
