Chinese and Mongolian UNEVOC Centres start collaboration

On Dec. 12, 2018, a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was agreed upon by two UNEVOC Centres, the Shenzhen Polytechnic (People Republic of China) and the Technical and Vocational Education and Training Assessment Centre (Mongolia).

Prof. CHEN Qiuming, College Board Chairman of Shenzhen Polytechnic, expressed willingness to jointly develop TVET in both countries.
