Russian UNEVOC Centre contributes to UNESCO Conference

The City of Kazan (Russia) carried out a forum on intercultural dialogue between the 4-7 September, to which the University of Management “TISBI” (UNEVOC Centre) took part.

The event was co-organized by Mr Mintimer Shaimiev, UNESCO Special Envoy for Intercultural Dialogue and State Counsellor of the Republic of Tatarstan, and the National Commission of the Russian Federation for UNESCO. More than 100 representatives coming from 25 countries joined.

The conference discussed new approaches of international cooperation to improve effectiveness of intercultural dialogue, within the framework of the United Nations International Decade for the Rapprochement of Cultures (2013-2022)
