Ms Lade Araba is the Founder and President of The Visiola Foundation, where in her role as a development finance professional she works to empower African girls to pursue STEM studies. She currently serves as an independent consultant and was previously Senior Adviser with the UK Department for International Development.

Carolina Casas is the Regional Director of Education and Outreach for Latin America at <u>Sesame Workshop</u>. The Think Pink Hardhat Challenge is part of the WomEng #1MillionGirlsInSTEM campaign in collaboration with UNESCO to empower 1 million girls through STEM education over the next 10 years.

Ms Aditi Prasad is the COO of Robotix Learning Solutions, which provides robotics education curricula for students K-12 drawing on innovations from around the world. She is a former Project Associate at the China Studies Center at IIT Madras and was part of the Executive Education team at the Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy.
