The National Development Plan for this Government term, entitled "National Plan for Good Living 2009-2013" was approved on 5 November 2009, through Resolution No. CNP-001-2009.

This document summarizes the main ideas of the National Plan of Good Living, a sustainable plan of development that is carried out by the Ecuadorian government, and the basis for the Cultural policies that are being practiced in the country.

The Ministry of Culture governs the National System of Culture in order to strengthen national identity and Interculturalism; to protect and promote the diversity of cultural expressions; to incentivize free artistic creation, production, diffusion, distribution and enjoyment of cultural goods and services; the safeguard of social memory and cultural patrimony, guaranteeing the free exercise of cultural rights; starting from the de-colonization of knowledge and power and from a new relationship between the human being and nature, contributing to the realization of the principles of the National Plan for Good Living.

The statistical information in this document has been gathered from two important initiatives of the Ministry of Culture.

The first one is the start of an Information System of Culture aimed at the elaboration and measurement of cultural indicators. This program is extremely ambitious because Ecuador, at the moment, has a very limited amount of cultural statistical information. The lack of information has been identified as one of the biggest challenges for the cultural sector. Without the proper measurements, the country has been unable to obtain a complete diagnostic of the situation. Therefore, it is difficult to truly define the real impact of all the measures that have been taken to elevate the importance of culture in society and in governmental actions. The development of this system is in the design stage, and national and international resources are being put into place for its advancement.

The second initiative has been developed with international cooperation, and it consists in the publication of a Cultural Atlas that provides an overview of the cultural situation in Ecuador. This project has revealed important results. However, the document has not been published yet. It is expected to be published in the next few months.

The information in the Report is the result of a long process of consultation and investigation carried out by the Ministry of Culture. This process involved gathering information from all of the Undersecretaryships of the Ministry of Culture, including those that are in charge of regional and local Directions. In a parallel manner, local Directions gathered information from civil society groups and local governments.
