	impact assessment in 3 ways:
	Discussing the pros and cons of using RCTs for
	evaluating educational programs and whether new
	analytical tools, such as machine learning, might be a
	complement or substitute for them.
	Synthetizing what is already known on the
	effectiveness of ed-tech programs across the world.
	Presenting the challenges and learnings from two
	impact evaluations of educational programs carried
	out in Peru (Profuturo) and Spain (EduCaixa).

- To show the feasibility and utility of impact evaluations in the educational field by presenting an evidence synthesis and real case studies.
