## Protection of Movable Cultural Heritage Regulations<sup>2</sup> (Amendment)

- 1. Amendment
- 1.1 The Protection of Movable Cultural Heritage Regulations are amended as set out in these Regulations.
- 2. Schedule
- 2.1 Part V, paragraph 2 (i):

Omit the paragraph, substitute:

- "(i) any holotype of Australian origin:
  - (i) that is not lodged in an overseas collecting institution; or
  - (ii) in relation to which a permit or an authority issued under the Wildlife Protection (Regulation of Exports and Imports) Act 1982 is not in force.".
