STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 14 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1992, the Minister makes the following Order:—

**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (ZONED AREA DECLARATION)
(KINGSTOWN) ORDER, 2000.**

1. **Citation:** This Order may be cited as the Town and Country Planning (Zoned Area Declaration) (Kingstown) Order, 2000.

2. **Declaration:** (1) In accordance with section 14 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1992, the public roads and alley ways, sidewalks and adjacent areas of Kingstown more particularly described in the Schedule hereto are declared a zoned area for public use.

(2) The following commercial uses are strictly prohibited —

- (a) retail and vending activities including but not limited to the vending of vegetables, fruits, food and drinks, souvenirs, clothing, dry goods and any other article;
- (b) the preparation and sale of food, drinks and snacks except at designated sites upon the issuance of a prior written non-transferable permit for a period of twelve months by the Physical Planning Development Board and subject to such conditions as the Board may think fit.

(3) A map of Kingstown delineating the zoned area referred to in this Order is available for inspection by members of the public during normal working hours from the 1st day November, 2000 and thereafter for a period of six weeks at the following places —

- (a) Central Planning Division, Administrative Centre, Kingstown;
- (b) Registry, Kingstown;
- (c) Kingstown Town Board

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT area bounded by the Kingstown Harbour Foreshore from the Cruise Ship Facility to the western boundary of Rose Place; continuing along the western boundary of the Kingstown Cemetery to its intersection with Cyrus Street; east along Cyrus Street to its intersection with the Leeward Highway; north along the Leeward Highway to the road junction adjacent to the Housing and Land Development Corporation (HLDC) building; east along the Public Road through Old Montrose and Kingstown Park to the southern end of the Level Gardens road; along the Level Gardens road to its intersection with the Mc Kies Hill Road; eastwards along the Mc Kies Hill road to Murray Road; north along Murray Road to the Sion Hill junction; along the Old London Road through Cane Garden to its intersection with Sharpe Street; south along Sharpe Street to its intersection with Bay Street; east along Bay Street to the Cruise Ship Terminal.
