

ICHO LAW

The Bill concerning the palaces of Niavaran and Sa'd-abad, and evaluating and maintaining the pertinent properties thereof

Date: Apr 12, 1980

Article 1 – All palaces of Niavaran and Sa'd-abad together with their sites and installations shall be devoted to the Ministry of Culture and High Education in order to create museum and park.

Article 2 – A commission composed of the representatives of the Prime Ministerial, Ministry of Culture and High education, Ministry of Economy and Finance Affairs, Bank Markazi Iran (Central bank of Iran), Bank Melli Iran, National Attorney-General, and Mustazafan Foundation shall examine and evaluate the properties of the mentioned palaces, and act as prescribed below:

A – All Antiquities shall be transferred to the Ministry of Culture and High Education in order to be preserved and maintained in museums.

B – All objects evaluated as more than 10'000'000 Rials shall be transferred to the Treasury of the Central Bank to be protected and maintained.

C – Those objects evaluated as less than 10'000'000 Rials, maintenance of which in museums are not advisable, shall be held in trust for the purposes, which will be determined in future.

D – All carpets evaluated as more than 1'000'000 Rials shall be kept up in museums.
