In exercise of the power conferred by Sub-Section (1) of Section 13 of the 1956 Ancient Monuments Protection Act, His Majesty's Government has prescribed the following objects within the Kingdom of Nepal, which are at least 100 years old, as historical; archeological and artistic objects, and prohibited the export thereof from the Kingdom of Nepal or their movement from one part of the Kingdom of Nepal to another without the prior permission of His Majesty's Government.

1. Historical Objects

Hand-written Vamshawalis giving historical accounts of any country; Manuscripts, gold-plate inscriptions, stone inscriptions, copper-inscriptions, wood inscriptions, birch-leaf-inscriptions, palm-leaf inscriptions, documents, coins houses where historical events had occurred or which were occupied by historical personalities, and objects used by such personalities.

2. Archeological Objects

Objects made or used by human beings of the pre-historical period.

3. Artistic Objects

Any important part of the house constructed in an impressive manner with figures carved on wood, stone, clay, bone, cloth, paper, metal, etc; objects used in such houses, images, temples of god and goddesses, pagodas, statues, inns, etc built with or without such reproduction of animals and birds or of both animate and inanimate objects.
