
- From Key Features to Action

Key feature 1.1.1 Ensuring that every citizen has the opportunity to become literate and obtain basic skills



Key feature is 1.1.1 for Sonderborg: Obtaining basic math and writing skills

Key Feature 2.2.1 Establishing community-based learning spaces and providing resources for learning in families and communities.

 - Volunteer Center, Youth House, associations, citizenship activities or family activities.
 - Spread all over the municipality to secure
 Citizen-involvement at the countryside's, small towns and suburbs.




