

Means of Implementation

Localizing development means

full participation of subnational authorities: from the setting of goals and targets - to determining the **means of implementation** and **using indicators** to measure and monitor progress

putting the territories and their peoples' priorities, needs and resources at the centre of sustainable development

sustained exchanges between the global, national and local facets

the achievement of the SDGs depends, more than ever, on the ability of local and regional governments to promote integrated, inclusive and sustainable territorial development

Subnational governments are policy makers, catalysts of change and the level of government best placed to link the global goals with local communities.

Subnational governments are policy makers, catalysts of change and the level of government best placed to link the global goals with local communities.

Development goals can be reached only if local actors fully participate, not only in the implementation, but also in the agenda-setting and monitoring.

Participation requires that public policies are not imposed from the top, but that the whole policy chain is shared. All relevant actors must be involved in the decision-making process, through **consultative and participative mechanisms**, at the local and national levels.
