### **Innovate Limerick**

Set up in 2015 by Limerick City and County Council, Innovate Limerick is a public-private partnership driving innovation in the region.

Spearheading projects such as the social innovation hub, a film studio, two county enterprise boards, and an International Cluster Conference.

Plans to establish a National Sports Cluster, with the potential for 500 new jobs in the region, are at an advanced stage.



# Strategic Partnerships involving education, local authority and industry

Effective models for market-led training involving cooperation between education and training providers and industry, in areas that include hospitality, film, engineering and ICT.

Over time, it is intended that these models be extended to engage with schools and parents to create a pipeline of skills.
