












Liangzhu Culture 良渚文化 (3300-2200 BC)





#### 2012, Ecological Civilization in China

- The Chinese Government has accorded the development of "ecological civilization" the same strategic importance as economic, political, cultural and social development for the country's well-being
- This emerging culture is an overlay on other civilizations and is associated with globalization, and global environmental concerns, hence is likely to have a profound exemplary impact on the rest of the world

## **Ecological Civilization**

- S. Huntington: "A civilization is the highest cultural grouping of people"
- The Greek root of ecological is oikos, meaning home or house
- Ecological Civilization, a clear recognition of human dependence on, and care of nature
- Consistent with "Nature and man are one"
- Requires fundamental transformation of its (consumerism) culture

#### Ecosystem in Rio + 20

- Ecosystem management:
   An integrated process to conserve and improve ecosystem health that sustains ecosystem services for human well-being,

### Ecosystem services,生态服务 MA 2005 (Chapters 14 & 17)

#### **UNEP** recognizes:

- Cultural perceptions and practices affect biodiversity, ...and human culture is strongly influenced by ecosystems
- The importance of cultural services and values (of ecosystems) is not currently recognized

# Ecosystem services,生态服务 2011UK Ecosystem Assessment (16)

#### **UNEP-WCMC:**

- Ecosystem cultural services are the environmental settings that give rise to the cultural goods and benefits to people
- Three quarters of people in England consider local greenspace to be a very important part of the local environment, and 50% visit it at least once a week
- Open green space and access to nature is important for children



 By 2020, at the latest, people are aware of the values of biodiversity and the steps they can take to conserve and use it sustainably







UNE Pdefines a green economy as one that results in improved human well-being and social equity, while significantly reducing environmental risks and ecological scarcities.




Culture promotes green economy thru mindset and behavior change leading to sustainable production and consumption
