


The Working Group on Capacity Development (WG2) is intended to provide a response to the critical needs of statisticians in charge of education indicators and to improve global data availability.

Expected outputs:

- 1. A **framework** that includes:
 - An inventory of key national education statistical CD areas to be addressed for enhancing national capacities in generating and using education data
 - A repository of CD tools, initiatives and funding mechanisms available for countries to inform their CD strategy.
 - A identification of gaps (in the repository) in terms of tools to be developed / improved and to strengthen coordination among CD actors.
- 2. Responses to the gaps identified through the mapping.







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Statistical Capacity Development Framework

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The Working Group on Capacity Development (WG2) supports the SDG4 Technical Cooperation Group (TCG) in responding to the critical capacity development (CD) needs that may result from the implementation of the new agenda at national level. Indeed, monitoring SDG4-Education 2030, will require mobilising a wide range of data sources and will place considerable demands on countries to improve data quality in its different dimensions.

The main objectives of the WG2 is to contribute to the identification and better understanding of the statistical CD needs; provide guidance for feasible solutions and plans that can be disseminated to countries and other partners; and contribute to the harmonization of capacity development efforts.

The WG2 met in Montreal, May 2017, and agreed on the necessity to setup a statistical CD Framework which will help meeting these objectives.

It is mainly constituted of a Repository of CD Tools and a list of CD initiatives and Funding mechanisms. The overall statistical CD Framework is presented in a concept note at the Resources section here below.

Repository of CD Tools

The Framework is built on top of the UNDP generic five steps CD process grounded into the SDG4 Education 2030 context. It is elaborated through the identification (the inventory) of key education statistical areas where countries may require support (national education statistical capacity needs). The Framework will serve as a repository in which for each of these areas potential CD tools will be made available as public goods to help countries develop their statistical CD strategy or simply to pick some resources of interest when needed.
