Madam Director - General,

In my previous letter addressed to you, concerning the murder case of radio journalist from Serbia, Luka Popov, I informed you that the perpetrators had been arrested and that they had confessed to the crime. The investigation that had been carried out established that the motive for the murder of Mr. Popov was robbery and not his activities as a radio journalist.

Having in mind that you submit an updated Report on the Safety of Journalists to the Intergovernmental Council of the IPDC every two years, and that the case of Mr Luka Popov will be mentioned in the report that is due in 2018, we would be grateful if the information we provided to you regarding this case were published on the UNESCO website dedicated to the safety of journalists.
