IIEP-Pôle de Dakar is the Africa-based office of UNESCO's International Institute for Educational Planning, a unique specialized United Nations institute with a mandate to strengthen the capacity of UNESCO Member States to plan and manage their education systems. Based in Senegal, IIEP-Pôle de Dakar supports the analysis, planning, and implementation of education and training policies in African countries. It bases its interventions on technical expertise, using a capacity development approach through the creation of partnerships, training, and the production of methodological tools and knowledge.

Its technical teams are mainly composed of education policy analysts, planners, vocational and other training experts, and knowledge management and networking specialists. The wealth of its human resources enables IIEP-Pôle de Dakar to intervene across a broad range of activities in the fields of education and training in Africa.

IIEP-Pôle de Dakar collaborates with many active development partners in Africa and is fortunate to receive significant support from *Agence Française de Développement* (AFD).

Analyses, carried out jointly with a national team, include studies such as an Education Sector Analysis (ESA). This detailed diagnosis of a country's education system provides a comprehensive framework to guide policy decisions.

CUSTOMIZED STUDIES

Education and training sector analyses harness both quantitative and qualitative approaches.

Methodological approaches developed by the World Bank, GPE, UNESCO and UNICEF serve as key references. Using a customizable approach to research, an analysis takes into account each country's context, focusing on certain sub-sectors or specific issues.

Since its creation in 2002, IIEP-Pôle de Dakar has supported the production of education and training sector analyses in over 25 African countries.

Using a participative capacity-development approach, this support leads to the revision of sector strategies, accompanied by a sector development plan and a costed operational action plan.

A sector plan provides a long-term perspective of a country's education and training sector and includes a coherent body of strategies, designed to attain set policy goals. Planners use various tools to carry out the different stages in developing a sector plan:

- **Financial simulation models**
- Financial frameworks for education and training policy options
- Strategic sector-planning documents
- **Costed and time-bound action plans**

The costing of education policy options and the development of an action plan can focus on a system's priority sub-sector or specific theme, at the government's request.

At the request of African governments, the implementation of measures can include a broad spectrum of activities:

Renewing Vocational Training Policies in Africa.

IIEP-Pôle de Dakar supports education reform in various areas of activity, particularly in the sectors of vocational training and educational guality management. To support the improvement of vocational training policies in Africa, IIEP-Pôle de Dakar developed the PEFOP, the Platform of

initiatives. This participatory platform enlists key vocational-training stakeholders to identify obstacles, develop action plans to overcome them, and mobilize the necessary resources for reform.



IN EDUCATION SYSTEM MANAGEMENT

In partnership with the Faculté des Sciences et Technologies de l'Éducation et de la Formation (Faculty of Education and Training Science and Technology, or FASTEF) at Dakar's Université Cheikh Anta Diop (UCAD), IIEP-Pôle de Dakar has offered a degree course covering the different dimensions of sector analysis since 2007. This training course, *Politiques sectorielles et gestion des systèmes* éducatifs (Sector Policy and Education System Management, or PSGSE), is provided in a university framework and can lead to the attribution of 60 ECTS credits, equivalent to half the credits required to obtain a Master's degree.

The total volume of learning is over 600 hours. including:

- ♦ 7 distancelearning modules
- ◆ 1 classroom-based module in Senegal
- ◆ 4 thematic group sessions (3 physical in Dakar and 1 virtual)
- 1 collaborative project and 1 personal project on country data

PUBLICATION OF THEMATIC RESEARCH


