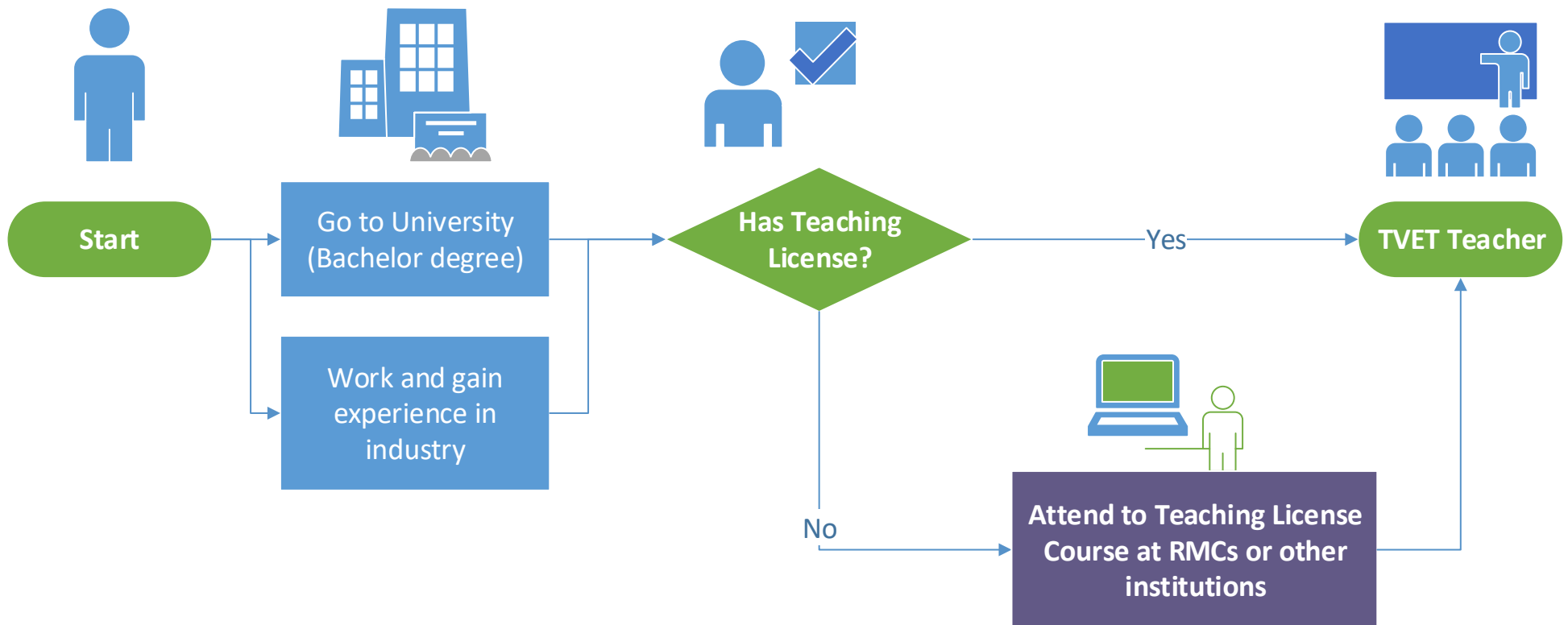

2. Attend “Teaching authorization course” of **Regional Methodological Centers (RMCs)**, if required;

Regional Methodological Centers (RMCs):

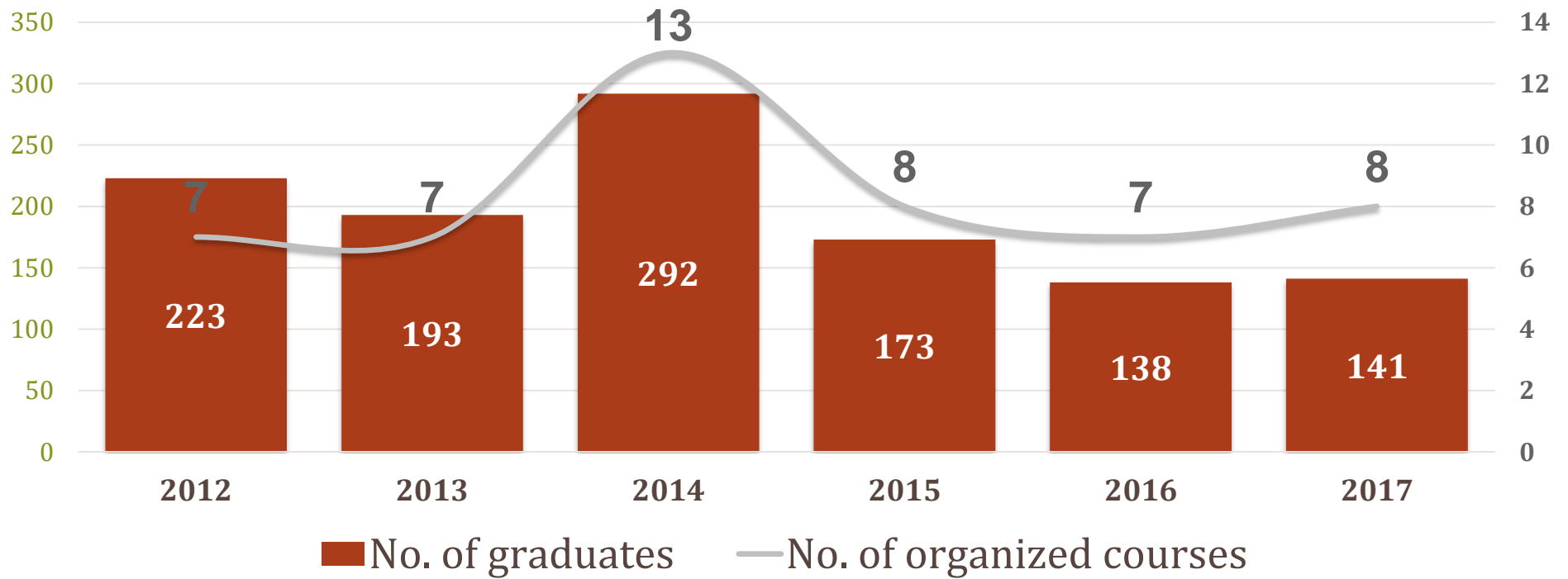
- Teaching license course at RMC.
- In total 6 RMCs in Mongolian TVET sector which organize “Teaching license course” for their respective area’s TVET school teachers.
- RMCs were officially established in 2012 as public organization unit, and consist from 5-7 staffs.
- Main purpose of RMC is to distribute the TVET content and pedagogy concepts from G

With two parts of training activities: (1) **Classroom training** which is in total **120 training hours/15 days** and (2) **On the job practical activity** which is **360 hours/45 days**.

Required qualifications for teaching staff of teacher pre-service training: Teaching license course

1. Educational degree with master or above;
2. Work experience of minimum 5 years;
3. Teacher qualification of senior or consulate level;
4. High level of theory/methodology knowledge at VET and labour market;
5. Have high level of qualification in competency-based training development and assessment;
