The Intergovernmental Information for All Programme (IFAP) was established in 2001 to provide a platform for international policy discussion, as well as guidelines for action in the area of access to information and knowledge, for the participation all in the knowledge society.

At its 180<sup>th</sup> session in 2008, the Executive Board endorsed the Strategic Plan, prepared by the Council of the Intergovernmental Information for All Programme, to guide the work of the Programme over the period 2008-2013.
