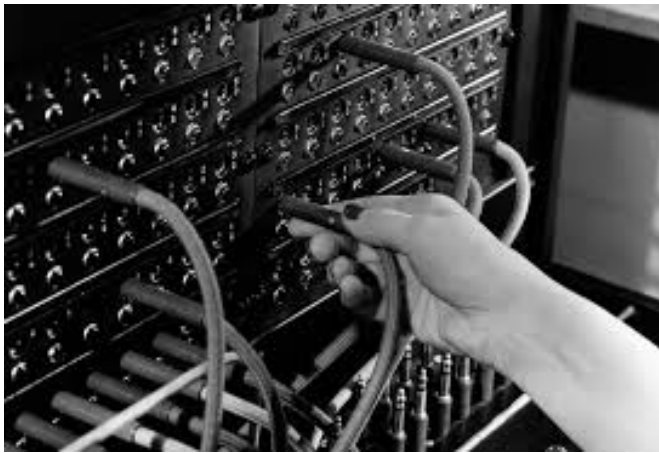

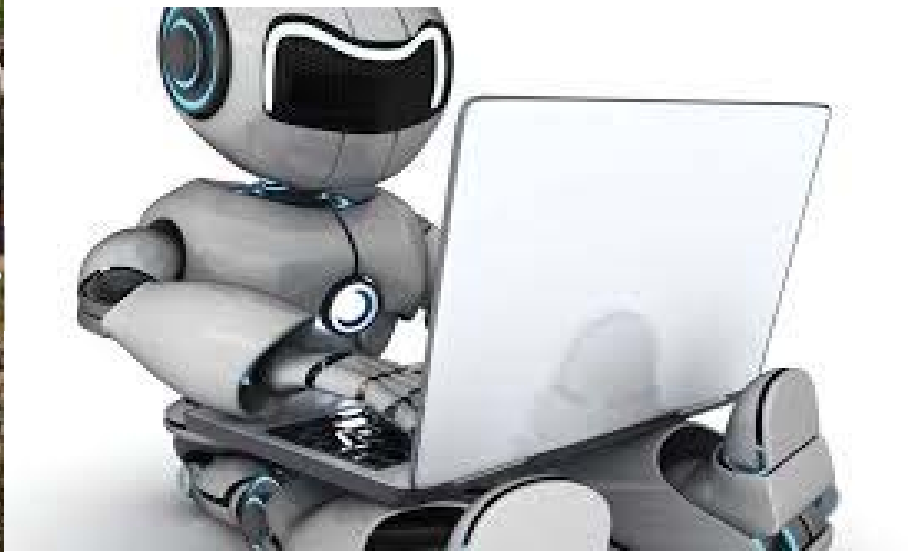
Does the digital divide between the developed and developing world threaten the era of technological transformation?!



It is impossible to imagine the daily lives of citizens without the Internet



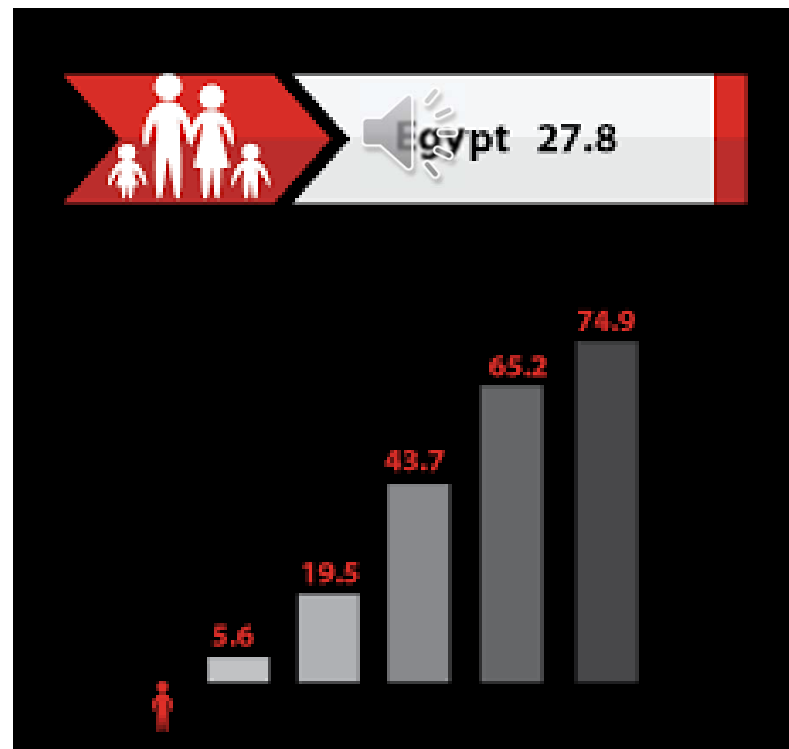
The world is half



Recently shown that nearly 89 million young people in the 12-24 age group are not enrolled in schools in sub-Saharan Africa



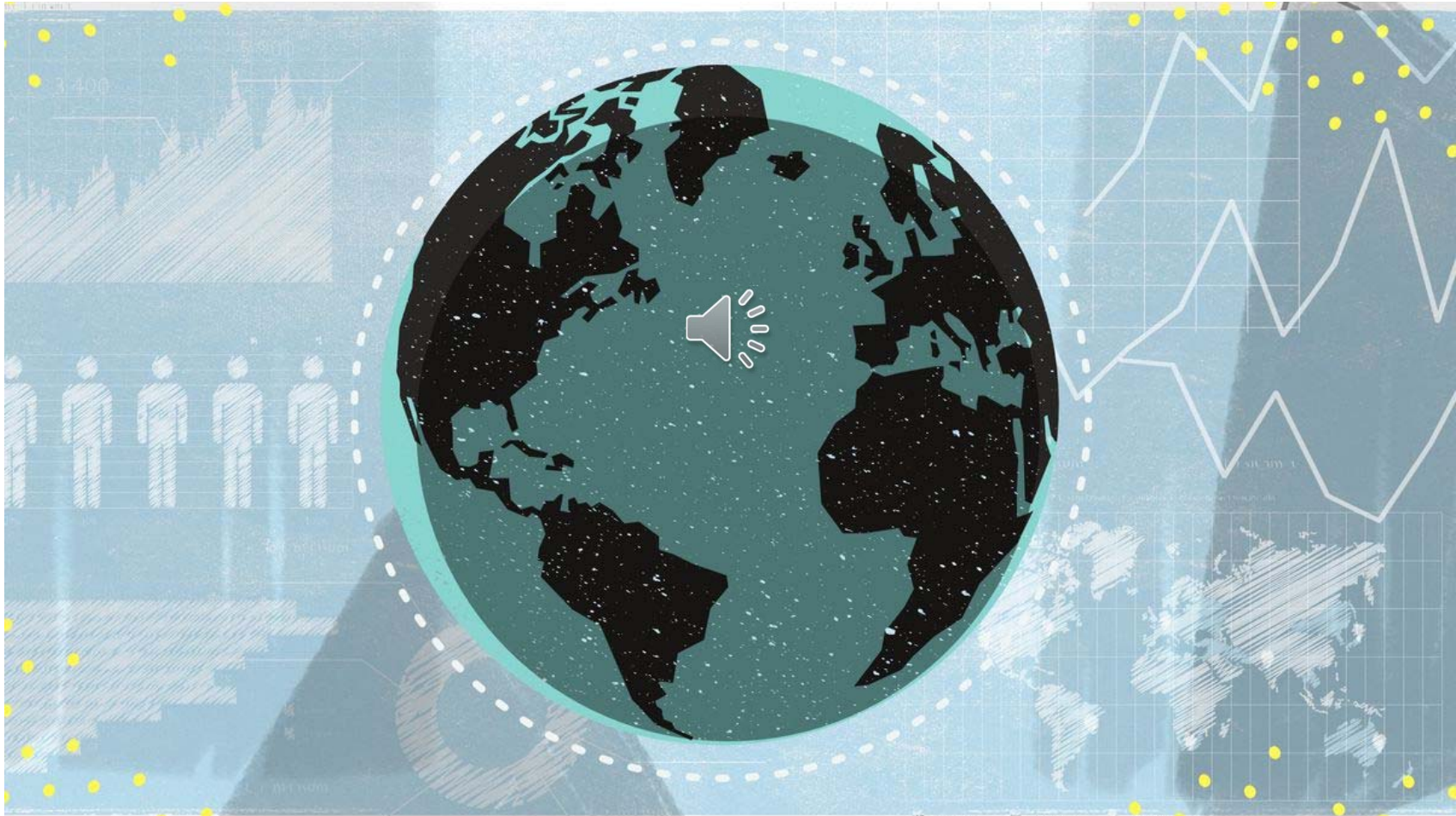
Example: in Egypt More than a quarter of the population is illiterate and most of them are concentrated in the 10 to 34 year age group
