LIMERICK COMMUNITY CONNECT 2000 - 2013

- Formed as Limerick ICT Steering Group in 2001 'to promote support and deliver collaborative and innovative approaches to the use of ICT in communities at risk of digital exclusion'.
- Renamed 'Limerick Community Connect' in 2010 and established as a Company Limited by Guarantee.
- Partnership between Limerick Community Education Network (LCEN), PAUL Partnership and Limerick and Clare Education and Training Board – LCETB (formally Limerick City Adult Education Service).










