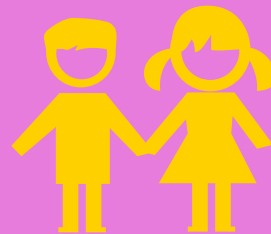

intercultural dialogue.



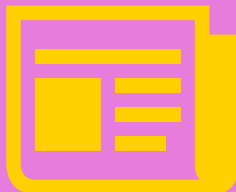
### ORGANISE A WORKSHOP WITH LIBRARY MEMBERS, STAFF AND STUDENTS
