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#### 1.4. Short description

Carpet making is an ancient traditional art of the Turkmen people transmitted from the generation to generation. Carpets and carpet articles serve as inseparable part of everyday life of each turkmen. Carpets are used as household paraphernalia and decorative elements.

Turkmen carpets and carpet articles are divided mainly in 3 groups such as:

**1. Floor covering carpets** (Large carpet, carpet for the seat of honour, a small rug (placed next to the hearth), a small carpet placed at the entrance of the yurt);

**2. Wall decorating carpets** (*Engsi*, a curtain shielding of the entrance of the yurt from outside, *Gapylyk*, a U-shaped rug for decorating of the yurt entrance from inside, *Torba*, saddle-bag for clothes and household things, *Chuval*, a bag for clothes and household things, *Khorjun*, saddle-bag for food and small household things, *Ikselik*, a rag-bag used for spindle keeping, *Uk ujy*, a rug that was used to tie the wooden framework of the yurt during roaming from place to place, *Umur-duman*, a rug for decorating the yurt's interior etc.);

**3. Carpet articles for various purposes** (*Asmalyk*, a rug used for camel's decorating during wedding ceremony, *Duye dyzlygy*, it was used for camel's front legs decoration during the wedding ceremony, *Eyerlik*, a rug that was used to cover horse saddle, *Kejebelik*, a rug used for camel's decoration during the wedding ceremony, *At halysy*, a rug that was used to cover horse back etc.).

Traditional turkmen carpet making art accumulates a combination of such traditional knowledge and skills transferred through demonstration practice and orally as a saryja sheep breeding, wool processing, natural dyes collecting and preparation, yarn making and dyeing, and, at last, making of looms and tools, carpet weaving and knotting.

**Knowledge and practices concerning the nature** related to the element involve a breeding of a saryja sheep, sustainable pasture management, harvesting of local dye plants, isolation of dyes from local plants, wool dyeing methods and preparation and application of the mordants from local raw materials.

**Traditions, rituals and beliefs** related to the element involve rituals at the starting of carpet weaving, ending of the carpet weaving as well as the role of a carpet in everyday life and ceremonies of the turkmens.

**Skills and traditional knowledge** related to the element transmitted by demonstration practice and orally from generation to generation involve a cutting of wool, spinning of threads, skills in dying and arrangement of colors and mordants, preparation of frames and carpet weaving tools, design and painting, threading, weaving of carpets and their finishing.

Carpet making art skills also involve decorations and patterns (gels) of carpets as well as restoration skills of ancient and old carpets and carpet articles.

Various sectors of the turkmen society are engaged in the carpet making art: shepherds, masters of wool shearing and wool processing, yarn spinners, dyers, loom and weaving tool makers, designers, weavers and masters of carpet restoration.
