Dikopelo is a practice, where people from a particular area come together and form a group to sing as a choir. The element is visible through festivals that are always staged during the festive season, especially on Christmas and New Year. In these festivals, one choir challenges the other to compete. This challenge for competition is usually done as early as February and in the meantime, the two choirs practice for the whole year in preparation for the contest to be held at the end of the year. Dikopelo are primarily based on the Bakgatla-Ba-Kgafela culture, farming, parenting, chieftaincy, livestock, seasonal issues such as stars and the moon most of these songs were loved by the older generation since they were about cultural issues.
