- Cabinet selected from the Legislative Assembly and appointed by the Governor on the advice of the premier. Following legislative elections, the leader of the majority party or majority coalition appointed Premier by the Governor; last elections held on 24 May 2017 (next to be held in 2021).

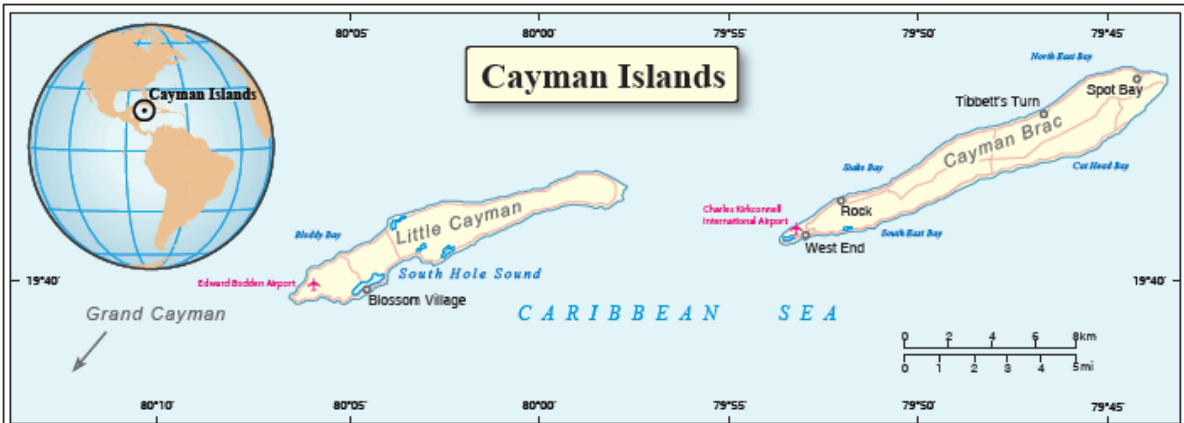
